Day 1:-

- ❖ Home work was given to the participants i.e. to write an essay between 200-250 words on the theme either in English or Bengali and to submit next day.
- ❖ Refreshments were given at the end of the session.
- ❖ Participants and their parents were excited at the end of the session. The parents were glad to know that we will display their children paintings in the Office campus next day.



Day 2:-

- ❖ All the participants submitted their write up in the mentioned theme.
- ❖ We made the participants to do some craft work with some waste materials like old unused plastic bottles and newspaper.
- ❖ We provided newspaper, gum, and scissor. Bottles were brought from home.
- ❖ The bottles were cut in two pieces and we used the bottom part for our craft to make a pen stand.
- ❖ Rolled small pieces of newspapers and pasted over the cut out bottom part of the bottle to decorate it, later colour the same and can be used as pen stand.



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- ❖ The main motive for the craft was to educate them that we can utilise those materials also which we consider as waste.
 - ❖ At the end of the session we announced that we will start computer classes and spoken English classes for them. We got good response for computer classes from both participants and children. We further announced that interested participants to give their name to Mr. Santosh Banerjee.
